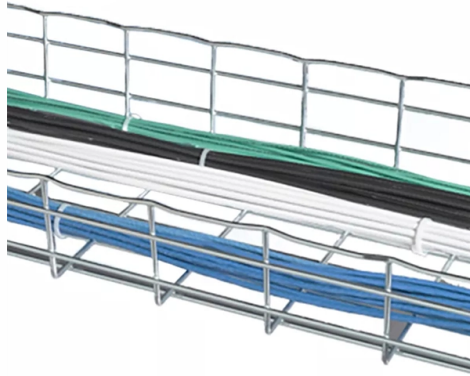

Overview

U (rack unit, RU) is a unit of equipment height in a 19" rack. Important: U describes height only, but a server's real "capabilities" are also determined by chassis depth, internal layout, airflow, rails, power, and expansion (PCIe/risers, NVMe). If you're installing a network switch in a 4U rack, prioritize depth compatibility first — most standard 4U wall-mount or vertical racks offer only 12-17 inches of usable depth, while many enterprise switches exceed 20 inches. For typical home labs, UniFi deployments, or small office edge networks. The detailed dimensions of "U" were established by the Electronic Industries Alliance (EIA) in the United States. "U" is not exclusive to servers but was originally used in rack structures for communication. The height of a rack is measured in Rack Units, written as U. A U is defined as 1 3/4 inches or 44.75 inches), 2U, 4U and other specifications.
