Fiber optic tracers consist of a transmitter and receiver: the transmitter sends a light signal through the fiber, and the receiver detects it to trace the cable path or locate faults. Common tools include:

- Visual Fault Locators (VFLs): Emit a visible red light to identify breaks, bends, or faults in the fiber.
- Optical Power Meters (OPMs): Measure optical power and detect light attenuation, ensuring signal integrity.
