Cable trays are not raceways, but they are treated as a structural component of a facility's electrical system. Cable trays support cables across open spans in the same. Answer: No. NEC section 300-8 does not permit. The primary rulebook of cable tray systems is called NEC Article 392. It instructs us on how to construct them, where to locate them, and how to stuff them with wires without using too much.
