Cable trays passing through walls must be properly supported, sealed with fire-rated materials, and installed to maintain safety, accessibility, and compliance with electrical standards.

Firestopping and Wall Penetration

When cable trays pass through walls, all openings must be sealed with fire-rated penetration materials to prevent the spread of fire, smoke, and toxic gases between rooms or floors . Common firestopping materials include fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, and fire-resistant mineral wool. For large openings, a fire-resistant backing plate should be installed before sealing. The gap between firestop packs and cables should not exceed 1 cm², and the packing thickness should be at least 24 cm . Cover plates should be square, evenly painted, and securely close the opening.

Mechanical Support and Tray Installation

Cable trays should be firmly supported and aligned when passing through walls. Use perforated or wire mesh trays to improve airflow and heat dissipation, and maintain adequate clearance between cables to prevent overheating . Ensure grounding continuity and inspect for mechanical damage, corrosion, or deformation before use. Only fireproof trays should be used for flame containment or isolation, and the tray coating or structure must not be modified .
