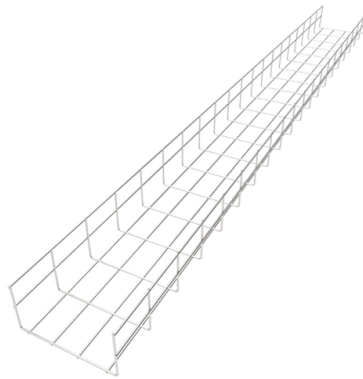


Can a 40G fiber optic cable be plugged into a 100G optical module for use
