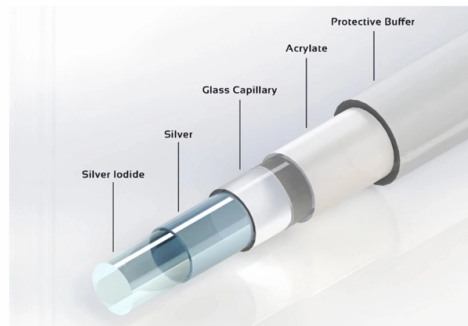


Can wires be connected inside a cable tray

- Secure cables with appropriate ties considering temperature, moisture, UV exposure, and chemical resistance .
