On June 4, 2025, Chile's government and Google formalized an agreement to build the Humboldt Cable, a submarine fiber-optic line that will directly connect South America and the Asia-Pacific region. As of 2025, the plan is to build a 14,800-kilometre (9,200 mi) cable from Valparaíso, Chile, to. In 2020, the Chilean government announced a plan to construct a subsea cable to connect Chile and Asia, followed two years later with an announcement to study the feasibility of a subsea cable between Chile and Antarctica. These projects offer opportunities to U. suppliers of fiberoptic and other.
