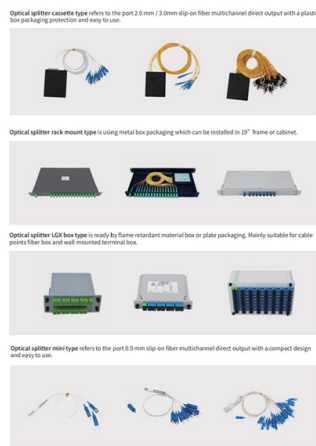

2. BiDi (Bidirectional) Modules

- Transmit and receive on a single fiber using different wavelengths
