

Configuration of direct connection terminal to core switch



AI Overview

To configure a direct terminal connection to a core switch, use a console cable to connect the terminal to the switch's console port, then access the switch via terminal software to perform initial configuration.

Required Hardware and Software

- Console cable: Typically an RS-232 to RJ-45 cable; some setups may require a USB-RS232 adapter if your laptop lacks a serial port .
- Terminal application: Examples include Tera Term, PuTTY, or SecureCRT .
- Laptop or PC with a USB or serial port.

Physical Connection

- Locate the console port on the core switch, usually labeled "CONSOLE" on the front or back panel .
- Connect the RS-232-RJ45 console cable from the switch console port to your laptop. If using a USB-RS232 adapter, connect it to the laptop first .
- Ensure the switch is powered on.

Terminal Software Setup

- Open your terminal application (Tera Term, PuTTY, etc.), .
- Select the correct COM port corresponding to your connection.
