Overview of PAM4 AOCs

Active Optical Cables (AOCs) use optical fiber with integrated transceivers at both ends to convert electrical signals to optical signals and back, enabling high-speed data transmission over longer distances than copper DACs . In 400G PAM4 applications, each lane operates at 53.125 Gbps using PAM4 modulation, allowing 8 transmit and 8 receive channels to achieve an aggregate bandwidth of 400 Gbps . These cables are typically plug-and-play, lightweight, and easier to manage in high-density racks .

Key Technical Features

- **Reach and Flexibility:** Standard lengths up to 100 meters, with breakout options like 1:2, 1:4, and 1:8 for flexible topologies .
- **Power and Latency:** Low power consumption (~8 W per end) and low latency, suitable for hyperscale and enterprise data centers .
- **Signal Integrity:** Integrated DSPs and VCSEL technology ensure superior signal integrity, mitigating crosstalk and insertion loss issues common in high-speed copper links .
