Grounding Practices

Copper wire can serve as the EGC in or on a cable tray system, providing a safe path for fault currents to the ground. When installed, the copper wire should be bonded to each or alternate cable tray sections using grounding clamps. This ensures electrical continuity and mechanically secures the wire so that magnetic forces during fault conditions do not dislodge it from the tray .

Material Compatibility

A bare copper conductor should not be placed in an aluminum cable tray due to the risk of electrolytic corrosion in moist environments. In such cases, it is recommended to use an insulated copper conductor and remove the insulation only at bonding points, using tin- or zinc-plated connectors to attach to the tray, raceways, or equipment enclosures .

Connection Methods

Copper grounding wires can be connected using:

- Grounding clamps or brackets at tray joints to maintain electrical continuity.
