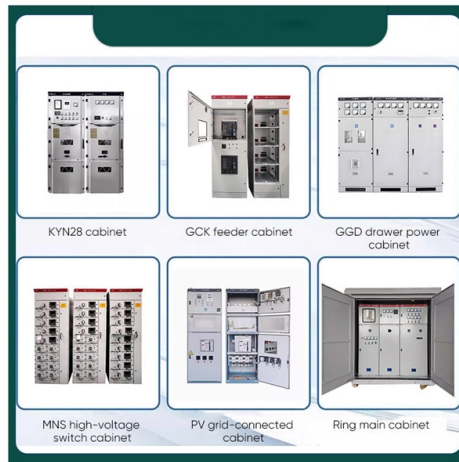


Current Status of Optical Cable Lines in Iraq



Overview

The Iraqi Ministry of Communications is intensifying efforts to modernize the country's digital infrastructure through two major initiatives: the expansion of the national fiber-optic network and the launch of a new international submarine cable link. A new sixth-generation fibre optic cable production line has been installed at Diyala General Company [Diyala State Company], a subsidiary of the Ministry of Industry and Minerals, with a design capacity of 15,000 kilometres per year.
