

Depth of cable tray mounting bolts



Overview

The fittings can be fastened to the cable tray rail either with double clamps of type DOP A2 or with truss-head bolts of type FRS and combination nuts. The exceptions to this are vertical bends, adjustable bend elements and fittings with a side height of 35 mm. Of course, variations without notice.
