Overview of Optical Cable Dimensions

Power optical cables, including both standalone optical fibers and those integrated into Active Optical Cables (AOCs), vary in core diameter, cladding, jacket thickness, and overall cable diameter depending on the fiber type and application. Single-mode fibers (OS1/OS2) are typically used for long-distance transmission and have smaller core diameters ($\sim 9 \mu\text{m}$), while multimode fibers (OM1-OM5) have larger cores ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) to support shorter distances and higher modal dispersion .

Cable Structure

A typical power optical cable consists of:

- Core: The light-carrying medium (single-mode or multimode)
- Cladding: Surrounds the core to maintain total internal reflection
- Buffer coating: Protects the fiber from mechanical stress
- Strength members: Aramid yarn or fiberglass for tensile strength
- Outer jacket: PVC, LSZH, or other materials for environmental protection The overall cable diameter can range from 2 mm for compact patch cables to over 10 mm for armored outdoor cables, depending on the number of fibers and protective layers .
