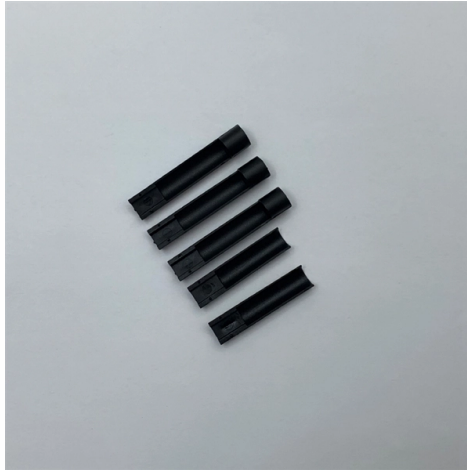


Direct Burial of Optical Fiber Cables in Trench

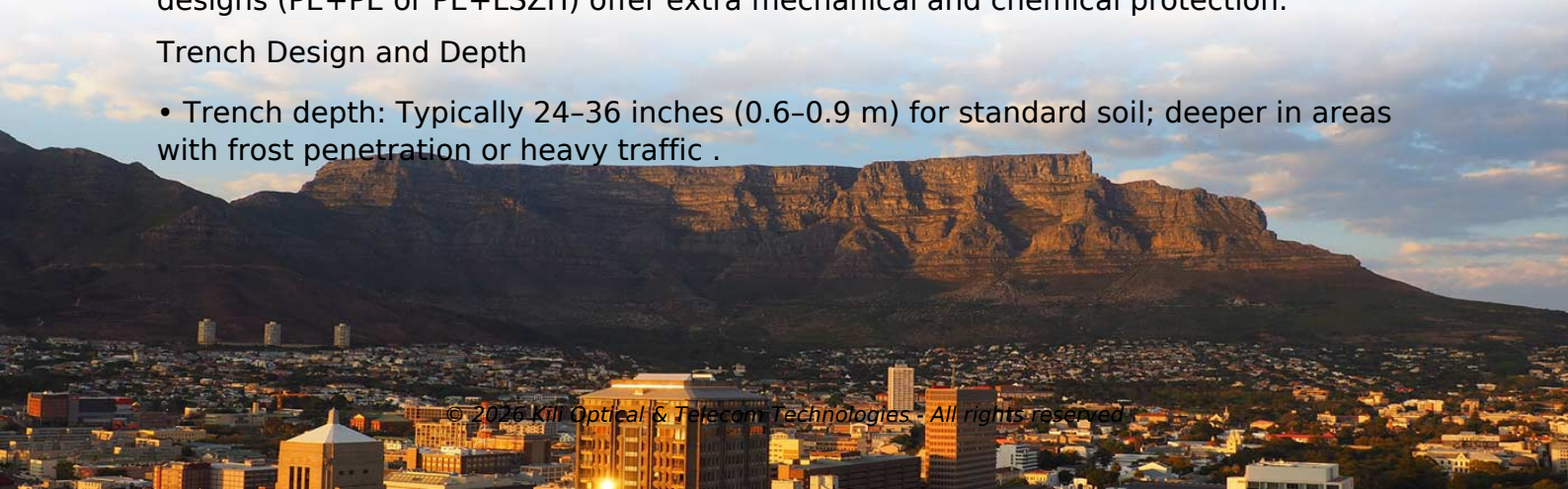
Cable Selection and Construction

Direct-burial fiber cables are designed to be installed without continuous conduit, with jackets and armoring to withstand soil, moisture, rodent activity, and mechanical stress. Common constructions include:

- Loose-tube, gel-filled or gel-free cables: Fibers are housed in water-blocked tubes, protecting against microbending and water intrusion; ideal for long outdoor runs .
- Armored cables: Corrugated steel or metal armor under the outer jacket provides crush and rodent protection, suitable for rocky soil, road crossings, or high mechanical risk areas .
- Tight-buffered or breakout-style cables: Easier for near-building terminations but less common for long direct-burial runs . Cable jackets may be PE (Polyethylene) for UV and moisture resistance, or LSZH where fire and smoke limits apply . Dual-sheath designs (PE+PE or PE+LSZH) offer extra mechanical and chemical protection.

Trench Design and Depth

- Trench depth: Typically 24–36 inches (0.6–0.9 m) for standard soil; deeper in areas with frost penetration or heavy traffic .
