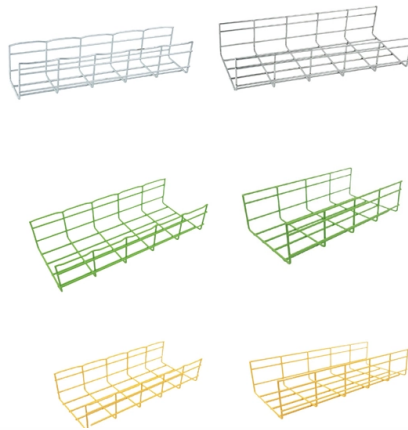


Distribution box should not allow direct wire runs

Safety and Code Compliance

Distribution boxes, also known as junction boxes or panelboards, are designed to enclose wire splices and terminations. According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), all wire splices and electrical connections must be made inside an approved box to prevent physical damage, reduce shock and fire risks, and allow inspection or maintenance (NEC 300.15, 314.16, 314.17). - Use raceways or conduits: Conductors should be run in multiconductor cables, raceways, or protected assemblies to prevent damage and maintain organization.
- Box fill compliance: Distribution boxes must have sufficient space for all conductors, splices, and devices. Overcrowding can lead to overheating and difficulty in maintenance.
- Accessibility: Boxes must remain accessible without removing building structures, ensuring that electricians can safely inspect or repair wiring.
