This configuration is especially important for outdoor or weatherproof boxes, as it helps maintain the enclosure's IP rating and protects sensitive electrical equipment from environmental damage . Proper alignment using a spirit level ensures the rods are perfectly horizontal or vertical, maximizing mechanical leverage against wind and other forces.
