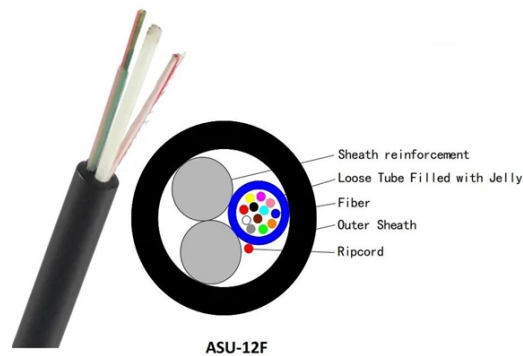

Types of Conduits

Rigid Metal Conduit (RMC): Strongest metallic option, ideal for harsh environments or underground installations. Provides excellent mechanical protection and grounding continuity, but is heavier and more expensive . **Intermediate Metal Conduit (IMC):** Lighter than RMC but still durable, suitable for outdoor or subsurface installations. Offers a balance of strength and ease of installation . **Electrical Metallic Tubing (EMT):** Lightweight, bendable, and cost-effective, commonly used indoors in commercial or institutional buildings. Provides mechanical protection but requires additional measures for outdoor or corrosive environments . **Flexible Metal Conduit (FMC):** Also called “Greenfield,” features interlocked metal strips for indoor industrial or commercial use. Offers flexibility around corners and vibrating equipment, and grounds naturally when paired with metal boxes . **Liquidtight Flexible Metal Conduit (LFMC):** FMC with a moisture-resistant PVC jacket, suitable for damp or outdoor areas. Protects wires from water, UV, and corrosion . **PVC Conduit (Schedule 40/80):** Non-metallic, corrosion-resistant, and cost-effective, commonly used underground or in dry environments. Requires UV protection if exposed outdoors . **Liquidtight Flexible Non-Metallic Conduit (LFNC):** Flexible, non-metallic option for wet or outdoor areas, providing waterproof protection for wiring .
