Users often experience 70–90Mbps on Wi-Fi, which is still sufficient for a 100Mbps fiber connection, but may not fully utilize the router's theoretical maximum .

Considerations for Optimal Performance

- Ensure the router has a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port if you plan to upgrade to faster fiber in the future.
- For wireless devices, using the 5GHz band improves speed and reduces interference compared to 2.4GHz.
