Overview

Once the cable ends are prepared, a rubber diaphragm at the box's cable entry hole needs to be pierced. This is to be done before inserting the cable in the box, as this opening is blocked in new boxes. Their function is mechanical stabilization, environmental isolation, and controlled fiber management. It functions as a junction between the incoming fiber cable and the outgoing customer-side fiber cable, where one fiber can be spliced, patched. The terminal box provides: Strain relief: Cable clamps and grommets transfer tensile loads from fiber to chassis, preventing microbends and fiber breakage.
