- **NEC (NFPA 70):** Defines Class I (flammable gases/vapors), Class II (combustible dusts), and Class III (ignitable fibers) locations, subdivided into Division 1 (likely presence) and Division 2 (unlikely presence). Equipment must be rated for the specific Class/Division and installed using approved wiring methods such as rigid metal conduit or intermediate metal conduit with explosion-proof fittings .
- **ATEX and IECEx:** International standards using a Zone system (Zone 0/1/2 for gases, Zone 20/21/22 for dusts) and protection types (e.g., Ex d for flameproof enclosures). These standards ensure equipment can safely operate in explosive atmospheres and are harmonized globally for international compliance .
