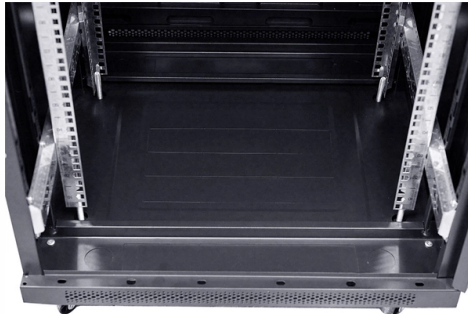


# Fiber Optic Cable Wiring Standards
