Mechanical Considerations

When placing fiber optic cables in trays, it is critical to avoid sharp bends, kinks, and excessive pulling tension. Cables should follow smooth curves, and figure-8 loops are recommended to prevent twisting during installation . The minimum bending radius specified by the manufacturer must be respected, especially under loaded conditions in trays . For vertical runs, intermediate clamping or hangers should be used to prevent excessive tensile stress on the cable .
