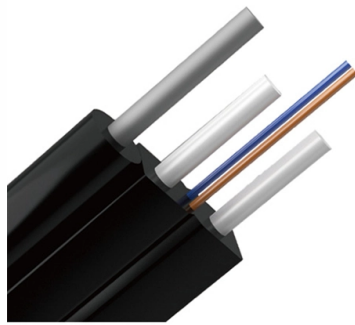


# Fiber optic cable line inspection cycle
