- **Lubrication:** Pre-lubricate the conduit with a cable-friendly lubricant to reduce friction, especially for long or tight conduit runs .
- **Wall Penetration:** Drill a clean, appropriately sized hole through the wall. Consider using a wall sleeve or bushing to protect the cable from sharp edges and to allow easy future replacement .
