Fire alarm linkage can be configured to automatically open cold aisle windows or skylights when a fire alarm is triggered. This is typically done through a fire controller or building management system (BMS) that receives signals from smoke detectors and executes pre-defined actions. Example actions include:

- Opening cold aisle windows or skylights to allow smoke venting
- Unlocking or opening aisle doors for safe egress
- Shutting down smart cooling systems or adjusting fan speeds to prevent smoke spread
