

Fireproof sealing requirements for cable tray openings in computer rooms

- Prepare the opening: Clean the area of dust, oil, or debris to ensure proper adhesion of firestop materials (ExpertCE).
- Packing: For large openings, install a fire-resistant backing plate before filling. Firestop packs should be placed in an orderly sequence, with gaps between packs and cables not exceeding 1 cm² and packing thickness not less than 24 cm (AIIPCB).
- Sealant Application: Apply intumescent acrylic or firestop mastic over the packed opening. Intumescent sealants expand under heat to block fire and smoke (Penosil).
- Cover Plates: Use square, evenly painted cover plates to close the opening, ensuring a tight and reliable seal without visible cracks or voids (AIIPCB). 3. Fire Rating Compliance:
