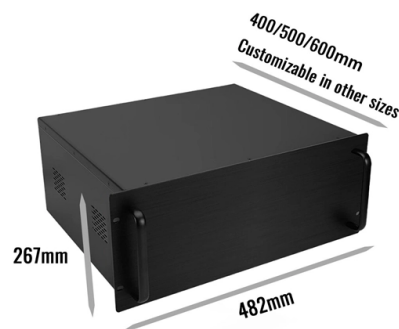


Firewall connected to core switch for internet access
