- **Phase Management:** In three-phase systems, splitters maintain proper phase separation and connection integrity, often using individual busbars for each phase .
- **Safety and Efficiency:** By consolidating connections in a controlled enclosure, splitters reduce the risk of electrical faults, improve system reliability, and facilitate maintenance or future expansion .
