

Grounding method for temporary power distribution boxes on construction sites

Temporary power distribution boxes must be properly grounded using a dedicated equipment grounding conductor and comply with NEC Article 590 to ensure worker safety and prevent electrical hazards.

Key Grounding Requirements

1. Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC): All temporary power distribution boxes must have a continuous equipment grounding conductor connecting the box to the main service or feeder ground. This ensures that any fault current is safely directed to earth, reducing the risk of electric shock or fire . 2. GFCI Protection: Most temporary power receptacles, including those on spider boxes, require GFCI protection per NEC 590.6. GFCIs provide additional protection by quickly disconnecting power if a ground fault occurs, which is especially important in wet or outdoor construction environments . 3. Assured Equipment Grounding Conductor Program (AEGCP): If GFCI protection is not used, the AEGCP can be implemented. This program requires:

- A written procedure for grounding inspections
- A designated competent person to perform daily visual inspections
- Testing of grounding conductors before first use, after repairs, and at regular intervals
