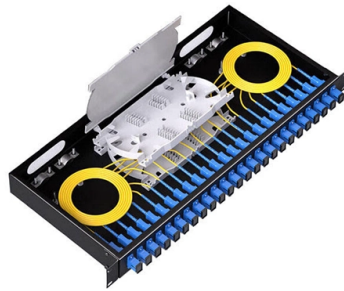


How high should the guardrail for the distribution box be

The top edge of guardrails for fixed distribution boxes should be 42 inches (± 3 inches) above the walking or working surface, with midrails installed midway between the top rail and the surface.

OSHA Requirements

According to OSHA standards (29 CFR 1926.502 and 1910.29), guardrails must have a top rail height of 42 inches (1.1 m) plus or minus 3 inches above the walking or working level. Midrails, screens, or equivalent intermediate members must be installed midway between the top rail and the walking surface, typically at 21 inches. Guardrails must withstand a 200-pound force applied outward or downward at the top edge without failure, and midrails must withstand 150 pounds of force.

International Standards

ISO 14122-3 specifies a minimum guardrail height of 1100 mm (approximately 43 inches) for platforms with fall risks greater than 500 mm. It also requires a knee rail and a handrail, with intermediate vertical members spaced to prevent gaps larger than 180 mm, ensuring safety around machinery or elevated platforms.

Additional Considerations

- Toe boards: At least 3.5 inches tall to prevent objects from falling.
- Material and strength: Guardrails must be constructed from materials capable of withstanding heavy impacts without deflection that compromises safety.
