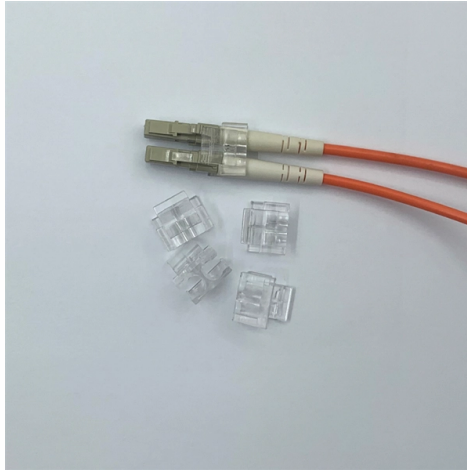


How many fiber optic segments are in a single optical cable

A fiber-optic cable, also known as an optical-fiber cable, is an assembly similar to an electrical cable but containing one or more optical fibers that are used to carry light. High fiber counts began with loose tube cable at 432 fibers, doubled to 864 fibers. The number of fibers is also dependent on how many units are inside the cable. The number of strands, or fibers, within a fiber optic cable can vary widely depending on the application, the design of the cable, and the specific requirements of the network.
