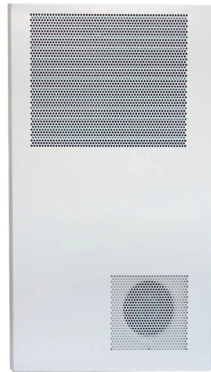

Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \frac{\text{Total Length}}{\text{Support Spacing}} + 1$ $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. TECHNICAL AND SIZING DATA

The supports are not placed at the ends of each tray sections, but instead are located at a distance no greater than 1/4 of the length of the tray (e.g. 1.5 meters for a 6 meter tray).
