

How many network cables can be connected to a fiber optic cable



Overview

A fiber-optic switch allows you to connect two or more fiber-optic cables to form a network. These can behave like a typical Ethernet switch. In addition, fiber cables can transmit data over several kilometers without signal degradation, making them ideal for connecting switches in large campus networks and between different buildings. This guide walks you through the simple decision steps engineers use, the common strand counts on the market, and clear rules-of-thumb for different project types so you choose a cable that fits both today's needs and tomorrow's growth.
