

How many wires are in the distribution box and how are they wired

A standard distribution box typically has five incoming wires: three-phase lines, one neutral, and one ground, with additional outgoing wires depending on the connected circuits.

Incoming Wires

The main incoming line to a distribution box usually follows a five-wire system:

- Three-phase lines (A, B, C) – generally colored yellow, green, and red
- Neutral line – light blue
- Ground line – yellow with green stripes This setup allows the distribution box to handle both single-phase 220V loads and three-phase 380V loads safely .

Outgoing Wires

The number of outgoing wires depends on the type of load:

- 220V single-phase circuits: one phase wire, one neutral, and one ground
- 380V three-phase circuits: all three phase wires plus a ground, and sometimes a neutral if local control is needed
- Special two-phase 380V equipment: any two-phase lines plus a ground Each circuit is connected to its respective circuit breaker, with neutral wires attached to the neutral bus bar and ground wires to the ground bus bar .
