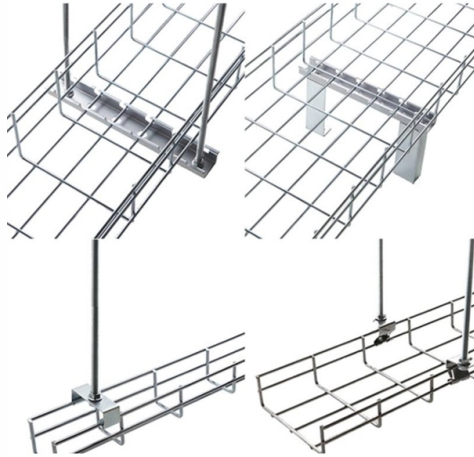


How to Choose Wires for a Home Electrical Distribution Box

Determine Electrical Load

Choose the Correct Wire Size

Select Insulation Type

Different insulation types are suitable for different environments:

- THHN/THWN: Common for indoor and conduit installations.
- NM-B (Romex): Non-metallic sheathed cable for dry, interior branch circuits.
- TFFN: Flexible fixture wire for lamps and small appliances. Choose insulation rated for the voltage, temperature, and environmental conditions of the installation .
