The Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \frac{\text{Total Length}}{\text{Support Spacing}} + 1$ $\frac{20}{2} + 1 = 11$ supports In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports.
