- **End-to-End Method:** Start coiling from one end of the fiber, fix the heat shrink tube, and then coil the remaining fiber toward the other end. This method is fast and flexible, allowing adjustment based on fiber length and tray space.
- **Special Situations:** For fibers that are unusually long or short, or when special optical devices are involved, coil these fibers separately at the ends to avoid stress and maintain organization.
