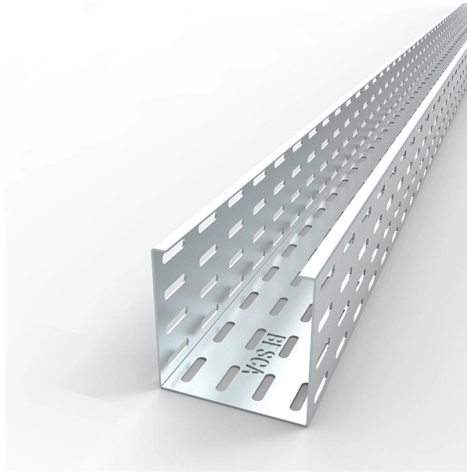


How to connect the fiber optic adapter to the casing

- Snap-in or latch mechanism: Push the adapter until it clicks into place.
- Screws: Tighten small screws on the panel to hold the adapter firmly.
