

How to fix horizontal cable trays on the roof



Overview

*Attach horizontal bracing to legs of duct supports, (approximately 3/4" of the way up the height of the support) with 3" bolt and 1/2" nut. NOTE: If double or triple bracing is required, designated locations will be marked on support legs. Adjust width up to bottom of ducting. Insert legs of duct support into bases and attach with. To ensure that the complete ladder tray wiring system performs as designed, it is important that it is properly installed. Personal injury as well as property damage will result if proper installation and maintenance procedures are not adhered to. 1) Use Cable Trays! The first and most obvious of these best practices is that you should always use cable trays. Rooftop installations are often subjected to harsh environmental conditions, including extreme temperatures, high winds, and exposure to UV.
