

How to fold a fiber optic cable in half

Fiber optic cables should never be folded in half, as excessive bending can break the fibers and permanently degrade signal performance.

Folding a cable in half would create a radius far smaller than this limit, making it unsafe.

Installation Guidelines

- Avoid kinking or twisting: Kinks can immediately damage fibers, while twists can stress the cable over time .
- Use figure-eight coiling: When storing or deploying long lengths of cable, a figure-eight pattern prevents excessive torsion and bending .
- Pull by strength members only: Fiber cables often include Kevlar or fiberglass strength members; pulling or bending the cable by the jacket can harm the fibers .
