

How to ground fiber optic cables upon entry into the office



Overview

Follow these steps at each cable entry point and termination location to achieve a compliant, safe ground bond: Identify metallic components. Strip back approximately 6–8 inches of the outer jacket using a cable splitter or ringing tool. Visually identify armor, strength members, or. Fiber optic cable transmits data as light through glass or plastic strands, which means the fiber core itself carries no electrical current and requires no grounding. This process prevents voltage buildup and potential damage to connected equipment. Identify Metallic. This Applications Engineering Note (AE Note) discusses conventional bonding and grounding practices for conductive fiber optic cable and hardware installations within the scope of the National Electrical Code (NEC).
