Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). However, it is always easy to overlook grounding aspects, or to fix them incorrectly. Often, the electrical enclosure will perform as usual with incorrect grounding, though will result in a danger. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
