

How to handle a loose ceramic ferrule wire



Overview

A good way to fix bad electrical connections in your wiring is to terminate the stripped ends of flexible wire with ferrule crimps. The best tool for crimping ferrule sleeves is definitely a ferrule. A wire ferrule is a specialized termination device, essentially a small, hollow metal tube, often paired with an insulating plastic collar, used to prepare stranded electrical conductors. But. Perfect Engineers, through its high-performance brand PE-LOCK, manufactures double ferrule fittings trusted for their leak-tight, high-pressure sealing. However, improper installation or use can lead to leaks, tube pull-out, vibration loosening, or fitting failure. We were crimping ferrules onto them with a square crimper that leaves ridges but since they were easily coming out by just tugging on them, we. **WARNING:** The CP-991 is intended solely for stripping and crimping. In doing so, the conductor and ferrules with cross section or sleeve length according to "Suitable ferrules and retrofit kits" on Page 12 are to be used. Only the PVC-insulated conductors may be inserted into the insertion funnel on.
