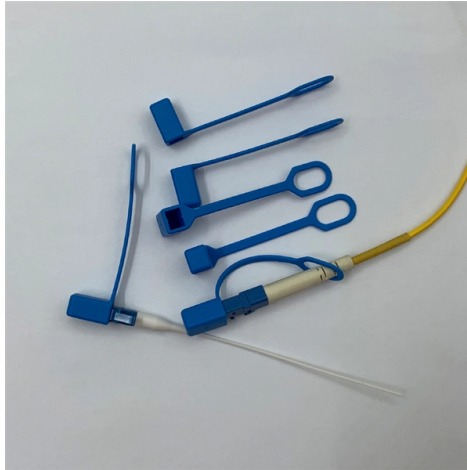


How to identify the model number of fiber optic patch cord connector
