

How to install a distribution box when the power cord is too long



Overview

Replace the entire cable from its origin to the new destination, or you can splice the cable and add the required length by using an approved junction box and cover plate. The junction box location must be accessible after the project is complete. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in. A cable distribution box is an electrical device used to collect, distribute, and protect electrical power.
