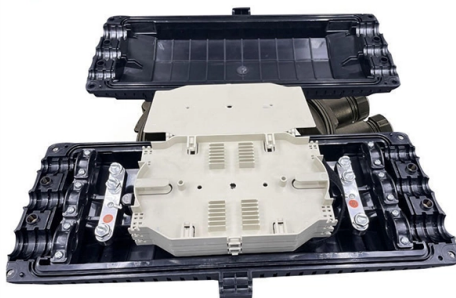


How to install bridge lights
