

How to remove the fiber optic patch cord connector

6. Store Properly Do not leave the patch cord hanging or scattered. Coil it loosely and secure it with cable ties or in a cable management tray to prevent kinks or damage . Replace the protective caps on both ends to keep the fiber clean and safe.
