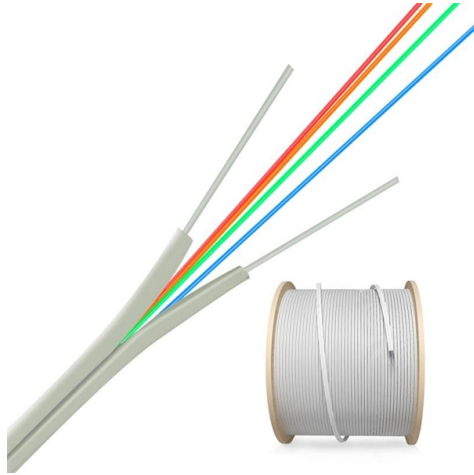


How to run the fiber optic cable to the top of the base station

Running fiber optic cable to a base station requires careful planning, proper tools, and strict adherence to cable handling and safety guidelines to prevent damage and ensure reliable connectivity.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, conduct a site survey to assess the route, height, and environmental conditions of the base station. Cable Handling and Pulling

Fiber optic cables are delicate and should never be pulled directly on the fiber; always pull on the cable's strength members such as Kevlar or fiberglass rods. Use a breakaway swivel or pulling eye to prevent twisting, and monitor the maximum pulling tension to avoid damaging the fibers . For long vertical runs, consider using an automated puller with tension control or a staged pull from intermediate points. Always roll the cable off the spool rather than spinning it to prevent twists .

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When an outdoor rated fiber cable enters a building, it should be spliced to an indoor-type fiber cable within 50 feet from the cable
