

How to run wires through a network cable distribution box

- Label each port on the patch panel to correspond with the destination room or device. This simplifies troubleshooting and future expansion .

Running the Cables

- Use Cat6 or Cat6a cables for modern networks to support high-speed connections .
- Route cables neatly through the box, avoiding sharp bends and keeping them separated from electrical wiring to reduce interference .
